False Bay is a very classy Chardonnay with flinty, minerality and great purity and restraint. A touch of oak adds complexity whilst extended time on lees adds nut and toast notes. Rich aromas of lime, mingled with peach. Nicely balanced with a degree of minerality at the core.

| 2 | Tara Paca Sauvignon Blanc 2010
Sauvignon Blanc is a refreshingly crisp white wine that offers citrus and tropical fruit flavors with very aromatic notes of green chilies, grass, herbs, asparagus and gooseberries commonly contributing to the bouquet.
Sauvignon Blanc is generally unadorned allowing the fruit to shine and highlighting the delicacy of the grape. | €22 | €16 |

| 3 | Tara Paca Merlot 2008
Merlot is noted for its capacity to produce accessible wines without sacrificing flavour or body. This wine unfolds with rich aromas of plums, ripe blackberries and an intriguing earthy note and follows through on the palate with remarkable smoothness. Tannins are fairly mild but sufficient to give good body and structure to this eminently drinkable Merlot. | €22 | |
| 4 | False Bay Shiraz 2010
A truly hand-crafted full-bodied Shiraz. A really elegant wine packed with rich, juicy fruit aromas, hints of cracked black pepper giving way to a black cherry and spicy flavour on the palate. This wine has fine tannins with a long rich, ripe finish. | €22 | |

This Wine is Ample and generous, the powerfulness of fruit is lengthened by buttery mellowness and acidity which restore perfect balance.</i>

Maison Louis Latour needs little introduction – having over 200 years of acclaim behind them. This is a crisp clean, mineral style Chablis that will not disappoint it possess a Pale golden colour. - 7 **Frattori Pinot Grigio 2009** €26
This wine ranges from toasted almonds and walnut shells to a hint of hay. Intense, yet still extremely fine and delicate, quite rich on the palate, enveloping pleasing and wide, very delicate yet full.

- 8 **Yellow Tail Chardonnay 2010** €26
Chardonnay when made in this fresh, leaner style is a lovely summery drink. A rush of peach and melon is met by more of the nuttiness from the bouquet. This is a lithe, seamless white wine. Serve with roast quail, pork chops or salad Nicoise.

This is a delicious champagne style, which embodies a lively, yet delicate and refined palate of citrus and fresh-baked brioche, together with a lively mousse, and lovely balance. Aperitif, fresh salmon, seafood esp. oyster, Thai dishes, fish and chips.
